



Medical Identification (iD) Flash Device

#MID01

iD is a personal electronic identification device that utilizes a custom USB flash drive to store your complete emergency medical information. The device features an auto-loading “form” which the owner completes to store critical, life-saving information that can be utilized by emergency personnel at the scene of an accident. Detailed information can be entered through the use of the form’s expansion fields.

Information such as medical conditions, allergies, medications, and even DNR and Living Will documents can be stored on the device to ensure that proper care is given to those in need. In

addition, the form includes a photo of the owner, and the device itself is easily recognized by police, fire fighters, and EMT members because of the universal medical symbol found on its exterior.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How can an EMT read the device? Laptop computers are standard issue equipment in most Police, Ambulance, and Fire Rescue vehicles. Once they discover the device on your person, they insert it into their USB port and have access to all of your critical medical information.

Can I update the device as my information changes? Yes, by re-inserting the device into your computer port, you can click on any field and update the information. The devices even include a password feature to protect the information from being accidentally over-written (password not needed to read the device).

Why would my employees find the device valuable? At the scene of an accident, time is critical. Detailed information about medical conditions, prescriptions, pre-existing conditions, allergies, and DNR or Living Will information can be accessed immediately, saving time, lives and potential additional disability costs. Having identification including your employer’s phone number, emergency contact numbers, and medical information readily available for emergency personnel is imperative. The iD offers adults a method of providing this in a small, portable, convenient way. The iD comes with a keyring so it can be stored on clothing, in a purse or in a glove box.
